## POLICY

That at the request of an owner or occupier of premises and on payment of a fee, Council will test the condition and accuracy of the water meter on the premises.

If the meter is found to be inaccurate, Council may charge for the water supplied on the basis of daily consumption equal to the average daily consumption during the corresponding meter reading period of the previous year or as the Council and the consumer may agree.

A meter is taken to correctly measure the water passing through it if it registers less than 3% more or less than the correct quantity.

If the water meter is found to be defective, the Council will replace it with one that is not defective.
