## The Sustainable Water Partner Program

can support your business

### STEP 1

#### IDENTIFY WAYS YOUR BUSINESS CAN OPTIMISE WATER USE

The program supports businesses\* to improve monitoring, leak detection and visibility of your water consumption.

We do this by helping you to identify water efficiency projects through advice or a water efficiency plan.

The plan will determine the amount of water your business is using, and where and how you are using it. It will also identify cost effective water efficiency projects and provide a tailored action plan for implementation.

We will support your business with these activities.



### STEP 2

#### IMPLEMENT YOUR WATER EFFICIENCY PROJECTS AND SAVE MONEY

You may be eligible for a water efficiency rebate.

Rous County Council offers rebates up to \$15,000 (per business\*\*) in any one financial year to undertake your water efficiency projects. It could be as simple as changing to water efficient tapware in the bathrooms, or a more complex water recycling project.

The rebate is designed to support your business to implement your water efficiency projects over time. You can access a rebate multiple times and undertake the work in a staged approach as your budget allows.



### STEP 3

#### BE RECOGNISED FOR YOUR WATER EFFICIENCY ACHIEVEMENTS

The program recognises businesses committed to efficient water use and sustainability. After implementing your water efficiency project, your business can be recognised as a Sustainable Water Partner.

Rous County Council will provide you with promotional opportunities to showcase your sustainability achievements to your customers and the community.
